



Canada Revenue Agency Introduces A New Digital Form For The Disability Tax Credit

The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) has introduced a new fully digital application process for the disability tax credit (DTC) claiming this will make applications faster and easier than ever.

What's new for medical practitioners?

Taxpayers can now obtain a reference number from the CRA after they complete Part A of the DTC application online or by phone. Using the taxpayer's reference number, you can complete Part B of the form through the [CRA's new online portal](#). The new dynamic form guides you through the DTC application. Based on the information provided, it will only ask questions that are needed to determine eligibility. Once completed, the form is automatically submitted to the CRA directly without having to scan or print the form.

The [traditional form](#) will continue to be available to taxpayers or medical practitioners who are unable to, or prefer not to, complete the application online.
